

GUIDED HUNT GEAR LIST

FOLLOW THIS LIST AND KEEP YOUR GEAR AS COMPACT AND LIGHT AS POSSIBLE

2 long pants	Gun or bow
2 long sleeve shirts	Ammunition or arrows
1 light weight base layer	Hunting knife
1 heavy weight base layer	Binoculars
1 light weight jacket or heavy sweater	Camera
1 heavy weight jacket	Compass or GPS
3 pair light weight socks	Disposable lighter
3 pair heavy weight socks	Small fanny or daypack
Underwear	Water bottle (must bring)
Camp shoes	Sleeping bag (rated below zero)
Toilet kit	Headlamp
Sun blocker	Insect repellent (archery seasons)
Sunglasses	Leather gloves
Insulated gloves	Heavy weight game bags (must bring)
Wet wipes (you'll figure out why)	Rain gear
Pillow case (must bring)	Fishing lures if you want to fish
Comfortable waterproof hunting boots (must fit in saddle stirrups)	

REQUIRED BY DOW

(Muzzleloader & rifle seasons only)

Hunter orange hat or cap

Hunter orange vest or jacket

GEAR NOT TO EXCEED 40# PER PERSON

EXCLUDING SLEEPING BAG, DAYPACK, AND WEAPON

Gear must be packed in an army size (36"x 16") duffle bag (no wheels). Gear and sleeping bag **MUST** be packed in a waterproof bag or heavy weight plastic bag. Put plastic bag inside gear bag, gear in plastic bag, roll top and close bag. You're gear is now waterproof. We furnish corudura rifle and bow scabbards for your weapons. Don't forget your license and hunter safety card. Leave keys and wallet in your vehicle.

BEER, SODA, AND ALCOHOL POLICY

All of the above are diuretics and can lead to severe altitude sickness. You're here for an extreme hunt at high elevation, not a party.

Liquids are limited on Alaska fly-in hunts and limited on our Colorado pack-in hunts as well.
